



## **Cookie Policy**

A cookie is a short record which is returned to your browser by a web server, together with the page content, when you fetch a page from a web server. It is usually a few tens of bytes long. Implicitly, your browser is asked to return this record to that web server when you fetch subsequent pages from the same site.

Using this information, the web server can then associate a request with the sequence of previous requests to maintain a "session". The web server can compose a page based upon what has happened earlier.

Cookies have a lifetime. Most cookies are, session cookies, and are destroyed when a session ends – when you close the browser tab or window. Some cookies have a longer lifetime and enable the web server tailor a page to reflect some setting which you made in a previous session – such as your preferred language, magnification or colour scheme.

Third-party cookies are cookies which the web server asks you to pass to a third-party web server. NELPG does not use such cookies.

A cookie does NOT give us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Although most web browsers automatically accept cookies, you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies to your preference. However, this will prevent you from taking advantage of our website.

We use cookies on our website and we assume you are ok with this otherwise please disable cookies in your browser or navigate away and clear cookies set by the website.

Cookies on this website are used for:

- 1. Maintaining a session and for remembering certain settings between sessions.
- 2. Functionality purposes to help us remembering certain settings between sessions. This allows us to personalise our content for you and remember your preferences and settings (e.g. your choice of language or region).
