



WEBSITE TERMS OF USE POLICY

Our Website Terms of Use Policy sets out the terms of access and use of our websites www.nelpg.org.uk and www.nelpg.org. This policy applies to all users of, and visitors to, our sites.

This Policy is to be read in conjunction with the following.

Changes to these terms


We may revise these terms at any time. You are expected to check this document from time to time to take notice of any changes we make, as they are legally binding on you.
